



CURLING CLUB

It's where you belong.

So you've decided to try curling and rented ice time - it just might be your first step in a life long avocation.

Here are some things you and your group should know about your rental.

ATTIRE:

- **Footwear:** If you don't have curling shoes, use a *clean* pair of flat running shoes. You can rent curling shoes at the Ottawa but quantities are limited.
- **Clothing:** Wear loose fitting clothing.
- **Temperature:** There are heaters in the rink so you won't get very cold. Dress in layers. Gloves or mitts are a good idea. You can always shed.

EQUIPMENT:

- **Brushes:** The Ottawa supplies brooms or brushes for one time renters. If you are a regular season-long rental, please invest in your own brush. The Hogline Curling Pro Shop is located on site with an array of brushes – even entry level ones.
- **Curling shoes & Sliders:** Rental curling shoes are available for \$5. Sliding devices are also available to help you deliver the rocks.

SCHEDULE:

- **Arrival:** You should arrive at least 20 minutes early.
- **Ice time:** You will have 2 hours ice time.

AMENETIES:

- **Refreshments:** Prior to, during and after the ice rental period, a full-service, professionally operated bar service is available. The bar stocks a wide variety of beverages as well as snacks. (Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the rink).
- **Food service:** Depending on your time and day the Ottawa's full-service, professional kitchen may be open. Hot and cold snacks, entrees, soup, salads and tempting meals are served.
- **Parking:** Space is available on site both in front of the building, on the north side of the Ottawa and on surrounding streets. There is also a pay lot to the south of the club where a flat rate applies to evenings and weekends – enter off Catherine Street. Heated, underground parking is available at the “Y” across the street from the Ottawa – enter off Catherine Street.
- **Spectators:** Family and friends are welcome to attend and watch. There is ample viewing space on the main floor through large windows. There is also a viewing area in the second floors. We ask that young children be supervised. Some board games are available.
